Builder Robert Mann has made excellent use of design, construction, and materials to provide a home of comfort and luxury in "The Gallery."

Off to the right of the tiled entry is a large study featuring raised paneling and built-in bookcases. The openness of the living area with vaulted beam ceiling and fireplace creates an enchanting atmosphere. A convenient wet bar and bannister

divider between the living and dining area add to the comfort and coziness.

The attractive kitchen is large and accented by a wood beamed ceiling and decorator cabinet doors. The openness is extended to the master suite which also has a vaulted ceiling, marble tub and separate patio entry.

Construction features include storm sash windows, blown cellulose insulation, stained ash trim and door trim, enameled walls throughout and 6-paneled colonial stained doors.

The entire design enables one to walk by each room without having to enter. The hall gives visual openness, but an unobstructed walkway.
